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8 **AN ORDINANCE OF THE KODIAK ISLAND BOROUGH ASSEMBLY AMENDING KIB CODE**  
9 **CHAPTER 2.10.030 COMPENSATION FOR REGULATORY AND QUASI-JUDICIAL BOARDS**  
10 **AND COMMISSIONS. AND ADJUSTING PLANNING AND ZONING COMMISSION MEMBER**  
11 **COMPENSATION TO CORRELATE TO MEETINGS ATTENDED.**

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13 **WHEREAS,** the code provides for compensation to members of the Planning and Zoning  
14 Commission (hereafter Commission) whether a meeting is held or not; and

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16 **WHEREAS,** the code provides for compensation to members of the Commission when not in  
17 attendance; and

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19 **WHEREAS,** current fiscal climate of the borough encourages savings wherever possible; and

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21 **WHEREAS,** current trends indicate there will not be Commission meetings every month due to  
22 fewer cases;

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24 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KODIAK ISLAND**  
25 **BOROUGH** that:

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27 **Section 1:** This ordinance is of a general and permanent nature and shall become a part of  
28 the Kodiak Island Borough Code of Ordinances.

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30 **Section 2:** That section 2.10.030 of the Kodiak Island Borough Code of Ordinances is amen-  
31 ded to read as follows:

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33 **2.10.030 Compensation for regulatory and quasi-judicial boards and commissions.**

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35 A. Members of regulatory and quasi-judicial boards and commissions shall receive compensation  
36 in the amount of \$100.00 per meeting attended, with the exception of the planning and zoning  
37 commission, which shall receive \$200.00 per ~~month~~ regular planning and zoning meeting  
38 attended. Work sessions are not considered for compensation.

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40 B. Regulatory and quasi-judicial boards and commissions include the planning and zoning  
41 commission, the board of equalization, and such others as the assembly may designate by  
42 ordinance.
