AN ORDINANCE OF THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KODIAK ISLAND BOROUGH AMENDING SECTION 2,30.060 ASSEMBLY ORDER OF BUSINESS AND AGENDA, ADDING A STATEMENT OF LAND ACKNOWLEDGEMENT.
